Situation

- ❖ There have been heavy Multi barrel, Artillery shelling continuously day and night at the border areas of the Mukamallai , Puliyankulam , Mannar , Manalaru and Poonakary areas in Vanni
- ❖ Roofs of 104 houses and useful trees damaged by the wind suddenly at Oddusuddan, Thunukkai areas in Mullaitivu District.
- ❖ Claymore attacked by DPU on 26.06.2007 at Mulankavil in Kilinochchi District.
- ❖ Mr.Asirvatham Thavam Father of 4 children killed on the spot by SL artillery shelling on 16/06/2007 at Maruthankery in Vadamaradchchi East
- ❖ Husband and wife were wounded by SL army shelling on 20.06.2007 in Vadamaradchchi East are given below:-
 1. Pedurupillai Francis sabarimuthu(husband) age 38
 2. Sabarimuthu Olinkanistra(Wife) age 33
- ❖ 03 individual IDPs wounded by SL army shelling at Madhu area is given below

- ❖ A9 Road connecting the North with other provinces is open only on three days Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays in a week
- ❖ People of Vanni Region are suffering by increased prices of food items and fuel.
- ❖ People displaced from coastal areas of Vadamaradchchi East to Chundikulam Village have acute shortage of drinking water and There is a need for a temporary shelter. Transportation of essential items is very difficult due to bad

condition of roads. There is no hospitals only once in a month mobile clinic.
There is a School of Vettalaikeny has 01-09 years classes with 2 permanent teachers and 03 volunteer teachers is only functioning at the area

- ❖ The World Bank approved Rs.1000 million to reconstruct the Iranaimadhu tank but no MOD permission to ADB so far to Kilinochchi.
- ❖ Tsunami co-finance fund Rs.250,000/= per beneficiary from world bank is still frozen for Mullaitivu District.
- ❖ General Hospital Mullaitivu got difficult with fuel for 8 month restricted by the GOSL

- ❖ Prices are increasing to the essential food items and fuel

Displacement and activities

Over the past two decades Tamil people in Srilanka have been affected by War and violence unleashed by the SL Army and the Para military groups. They also were affected by Tsunami in December 2004.

However the violence increased in December 2005, after the New Government won the election in November 2005. A number of People have been displaced in North East by Multi barrel artillery shelling, Ariel attacks, forward troop movements of the SL army and DPU attacks

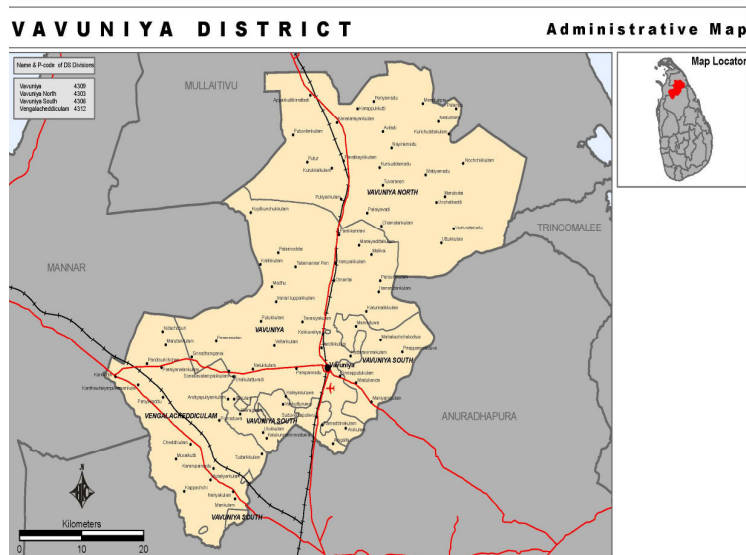
The displaced people are assisted by NGOs UN Organizations and Local NGOs. Some areas are not covered by INGOs for reasons of security.

TRO with its partner organizations are on the spot to provide the essential needs drinking water, food , cloth, shelters and transportation.

Ever the ceasefire agreement conduct bring the descried normalcy due to increased military and paramilitary activities.

Vavuniya District

In the areas of North Vavuniya which comes under regular attacks Shelling , air strikes and DPU of SL Army due to above reasons People have been displacing to safer areas..

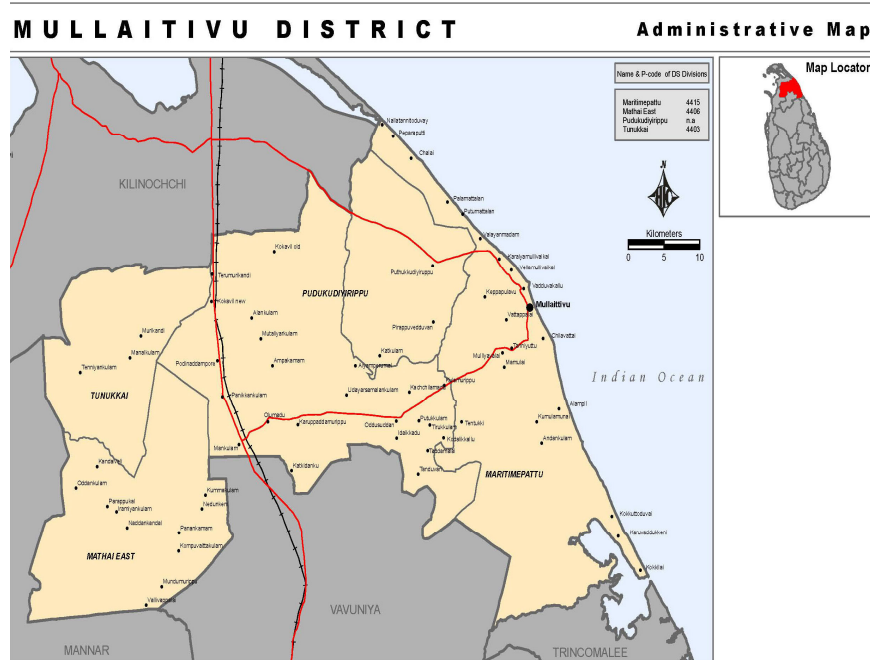

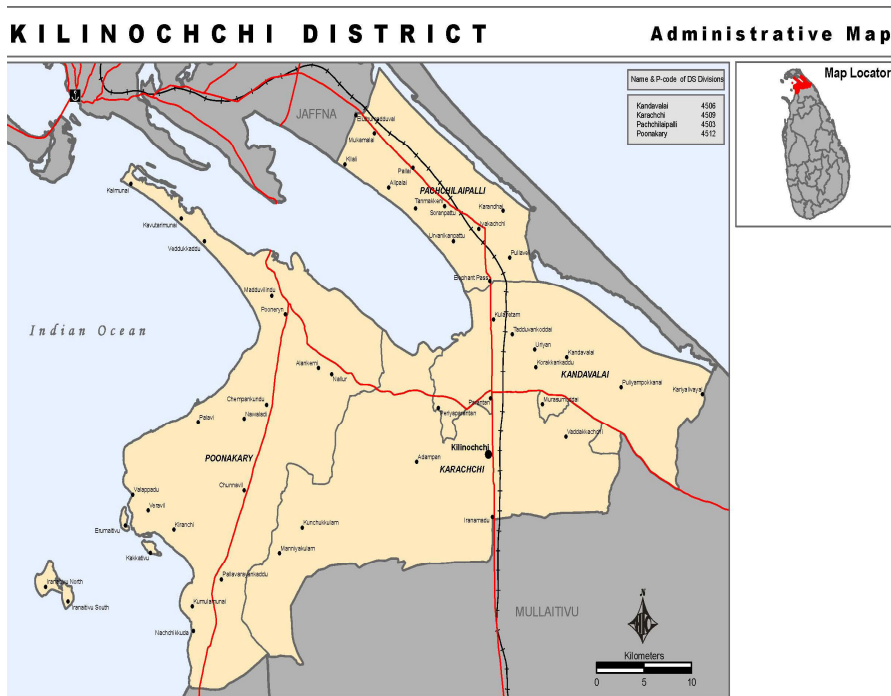

KILINOCHCHI DISTRICT

People of Kilinochchi was displaced in 1996 by the SL army operation which was “Sathjeya operation” and they had lost livelihood, they resettled after year of 2000 then was getting up livelihood support with faming and other income generation. Now people are increased by registering of IDPs who were displaced from Jaffna, Mannar, Batticaloa, Trincomalee and Vavuniya after the situation changed by the military operation since April 2006

Vadamaradchchi East (JAFFNA DISTRICT)

People of Vadamaradchchi East who were 3551 returned families living after the peace process agreement signed between both the GOSL and the LTTE in 2002.

They all had fishing to their livelihood, then displaced again by 11.08.2006 troops movement forwarded to the FDL areas and shelling, air strikes, Navy attacks too

Now 491 families living at Chundikulam Coastal area, who got difficulties with accommodation and transportation to hospital and other needs

A team have gone from TRO head office discussed with the IDPs at Chundikulam then find out the needs required which are very important to the IDPs is given below the work list is to be done.

1. temporary shelter
2. well and toilet
3. renovation of road
4. temporary preschool
5. temporary school cottage

TRO begun the work of renovation of the road supported with beneficiaries on 20/06/2007, it is 18Km length of road from Kervil to Nallathannithoduvai

food Supply

TRO –Through IDRO provided dry food item to 358 families and Milk food packets to 200 Children at Periyamadhu. And Provided Dry food to a Displaced family



Non Food Relief Item

- ❖ TRO through TRRO provided temporary shelter and non food items to a family whose house was burnt .
- ❖ TRO-PMDO provided temporary shelter to 08 IDPs families at Jeyapuram area and NFRI for 34 families from Jaffna.
- ❖ TRO through NEDRO distributed NFRI to a family from Trincomalee living at Kanakapuram.
- ❖ TRO through KNDO distributed dry food, NFRI, Milk food to a family living at Tharmapuram.
- ❖ TRO through ADO distributed NFRI for three families from Mannar.

Transport

TRO have arranged transportation to the people who were displaced from various Districts and Villages.

There are a 5Km road damaged want to be repaired and clearing use by Periyamadhu IDPs.

TRO begun the renovation of 18km road from Kevil to Nallathannithoduvai using by People from Vadamaradchchi East living at Chundikulam

Water & sanitation

TRO have been distributing drinking water and sanitation facilities to People who are living in Welfare centers and temporary shelters after the displacement.

TRO-IDRO repaired 38 toilets at Periyamadhu.

TRO through TRRO-Mullai provided temporary shelter for 3 families, Dryration to 04 families, cloth to one family who were under vulnerable living at Kaiveli, Iranaippalai, Venavil, Puthukkudiyiruppu and Nesan Kudiyiruppu.

TRO through TRRO Mullai have arranged to rebuild the 11 houses with cadjan, timber of the people who were completely lost their house by air strikes on 29th, 30th of May 2007 at Vevavil area

TRO through NDRO provided Milk food for 02 children, non food item for 03 families, panadol syrup for 20 children, lactogen 1&2 for 132 children, Grape water for 32 children who were identified malnutrition children of the Villages are Kanagarajankulam, Periyakulam, Mannakulam, Alankulam, Puthukulam, Kurisuddakulam

TRO Provided temporary shelter for 2 families who were vulnerable at kanagarajankulam and Periyakulam in Vavuniya North.

TRO through PDRO provided temporary shelter and Non food item for a family was lost their home by burning at Mudkompan area.

TRO through NEDRO provided material to build temporary house for a family displaced from Jaffna. And distributed cadjan for 03 families under vulnerable at Ganeshpuram, Selvanagar and Ananthapuram in Kilinchchi District.

TRO Kili provided dry food, milk food ,NFRI for 03 families under vulnerable who were from Paranthan and Vadakadu areas.

TRO through PTRO provided milk food packets for 25 children who added under vulnerable families at Puthuvettuvaan, Iyangankulam, Palaiyamurikandy and Mangainagar areas.

TRO through RRDO provided dry food and NFRI for a family under vulnerable at Uttupulam Village.

TRO through KDRRO distributed food item to funeral in Kilinochchi and provided milk food, dry food for family at Paranthan.

TRO through KERO distributed material to build a house whose burnt at Vaddakachchi.

TRO through PMDO supplied drinking water to areas of Eelavur, Valaippadu, Palavi, Perijedupadu and Veerapandiyamunai in Kilinochchi District.

- TRO-PSEDC opened a permanent preschool on 25.06.2007 supporting by UN Habitat in Kilinochchi.
- The training program which conducted by PSEDC for Preschool teachers in Vanni.

Nutrition Centers

TRO through KERO distributing nutrition food for 54 preschool children at Vaddakachchi.

TRO through NEDRO provided nutrition food for children at Maruthanagar.
