


Aerial Bombings of Tamil Homeland Never Condemned by Aid Donors to Sri Lanka













Clearing the Kfir Confusion

Basic Anatomy of a Kfir



Kfir C.2 and CT.2 are similar bombers. T means Trainer having two-seats.

French First Builds Mirage-III

- Private French company Dassault builds airframe for Mirage
- Government-owened SNECMA builds Atar-9x jet engines
- Mirage-III has low power Atar-9B jet engine
- Israel buys and uses Mirage-III to fight 6-day war (1967)
- French cancels selling new Mirage-5J to Israel due to foreign policy change after the 6-day war ends.

Israel's Kfir Program

- Israeli agents secure Atar-9C jet engine & airframe production drawings of Mirage-5J after French embargo
- Exact copy Mirage-5J design by Israel is now called Nesher (1969)
- 40 Neshers deployed in Yom Kippur war (1973)
- Low power Neshers (17) are shot down in Falkland war by British
- Nesher's jet engine upgraded to GE-J79 (+10% air mass intake)
- Mirage-5J-based Nesher with GE-J79 is now called Kfir project
- Only 27 basic Kfirs (misnamed as C.1) were produced
- Canard wings and new avionics added to Kfirs & named Kfir C.2 (1976)
- 1989 Israel considers re-engining old C.2 of a fleet of ~80 with Atar-9K-50 turbojet to circumvent American control of sales on exporting GE-J79 engines (General Electric). Target customer of this design: S. Africa

Modified Kfirs Sold to Sri Lanka in 1995 & 2000 Sri Lanka?

- Re-engined Kfir C.2 not requiring American clearance are sold to Sri Lanka?
 (manufacturer of Atar-9K-50 engine is French-SNECMA)
- Sales of Kfir C.2 to Sri Lanka is not listed in US sales manifest to Sri Lanka (see Federation of American Scientist website). Is it because it has no GE engine or is the American public is not being well informed?
